Staff Reports

Clerk – Bi-State is working on updating our logo. Got a quote for the basketball hoop replacement. IAMU insurance refund is \$1521. We have a new door lock that will remove the need for people to come get a key when they rent the hall. Spoke to the county about Cody Rd. Spoke to Alliant about the light pole that fell.

Maintenance – Fixing potholes. Some people have taken it upon themselves to put gravel in some potholes. This makes our work twice as hard as it all has to be removed in order to be repaired. Cleaning up gravel from winter plowing. Discussed getting floors in the civic center waxed. Clerk will get some prices.

Department Reports

Parks & Rec – Baseball practice has started. Will get new basketball hoop and net. Public Works – Schultz provided a written report. Getting quotes for road work and generator for city hall.

Public Safety – Stewart waiting on street painting quote. Want to increase sheriff's coverage from 10 hours to 15 hours per week. Gathering information on speed cameras.

General Government – Need to get the equipment replacement plan completed and then move money into it. Resolution discussed last month was missed.

Business – Discussed giving away the 2 computers at city hall because they are not being used. This will be done through a drawing. It was moved by Shipman and seconded by Stewart to donate the computers through a drawing to be held at the May council meeting. All ayes, motion carried. The Clerk will publicize it.

It was moved by Shipman and seconded by Stewart to authorize the creation of a dog park near the pavilion area. All ayes, motion carried.

The snow removal policy was revised as discussed. It was moved by Shipman and seconded by Claussen to approve the policy. All ayes, motion carried.

Spring cleanup was discussed. Since we have bulk waste pickup available year round, we will not do a curbside cleanup. We will have an electronic waste cleanup on May 18th from 9am-noon. It was moved by Claussen and seconded by Shipman to have the electronics waste day. All ayes, motion carried. The Clerk will publicize it.

Public Comments – Dipple mentioned that the stop sign flashing lights aren't working because the fallen light pole broke some wiring. He will get it fixed. Next meeting the Fire Department will have an offer to buy the squad car.
